With a light straw color, this wine opens with lovely aromas of tangerine, honeysuckle and a hint of peach blossom. The elegant fruit and floral tones continue to build leading to flavors of orange marmalade, lemon blossom and nectarine before the long and smooth finish.

The CRŪ Viognier pairs well with a variety of foods. We recommend pairing it with lamb accented by crispy pancetta.
