First planted in 1971, the vineyard is located in Northern Santa Barbara County, near the western edge of the Santa Maria Valley. The Sierra Madre Vineyard is recognized as one of California's finest coolclimate vineyards and the coldest vineyard in the state leading to a long, drawn-out growing season.



This velvety wine has a wonderful dark cherry color with layered aromas of raspberry, cherry, roses and toasted nuts. The palate is delightfully balanced with acidity and soft tannins with flavors of strawberry, bright cherry, coconut, and baking spices.

The rich fruit in this wine pairs beautifully with the sweet and savory flavors of barbeque short ribs.
