The 2019 CRU GSM was sourced from the French Camp Vineyard in the Paso Robles Highlands District. Located just north of the Temblor Mountains at the southeastern corner of the Paso Robles AVA, French Camp Vineyard has one of the more unique terroirs (combination of rainfall, temperature, and soils) for growing grapes in California.

TASTING NOTES

GSM stands for Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre, three grapes traditionally grown and blended together in the Rhône region of France. We took inspiration from this classic blend to create our own GSM wine that showcases the red fruits and rich flavors GSM blends are known for.

This wine is a complex blend of fresh flavors of cherry and raspberry balanced beautifully with tones of dark chocolate and coffee. The finish is long with elegant structure and tannin.

The abundance of flavors in this wine makes it ideal for pairing with a variety of foods. We recommend pairing it with ribeye steak prepared with a spicy rub or topped with blue cheese crumbles.
