Edna Valley is the coolest growing region in all of California at a mere 5.4 miles from the Pacific Ocean. The ocean's influence creates an unusually long growing season and allows the fruit in these vineyards to ripen to its full flavor while preserving its trademark lively acidity. In short, the Edna Valley is one of the best places on earth for growing pure, vibrant white wine grapes.

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 CRŪ Albariño is a lovely example of how aging in stainless steel brings out the true essence of this wine. The fermentation enhances the natural fresh fruit characteristics found in Albariño, intensifying the zingy flavors of grapefruit and green apple. Bright acidity is prevalent throughout and beautifully balanced with notes of melon, papaya and pineapple with a hint of minerality on the finish.

Albariño is a perfect companion to seafood. Try it with fresh or barbequed oysters in a garlic butter sauce.
