The 2021 CRU GSM was sourced from the French Camp Vineyard in the Paso Robles Highlands District. Located just north of the Temblor Mountains at the southeastern corner of the Paso Robles AVA, French Camp Vineyard has one of the more unique terroirs (combination of rainfall, temperature, and soils) for growing grapes in California.

TASTING NOTES

GSM stands for Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre, three grapes traditionally grown and blended together in the Rhône region of France. We took inspiration from this classic blend to create our own GSM wine that showcases the red fruits and rich flavors GSM blends are known for.

This complex wine opens with jammy fruit notes of raspberry and black cherry that develop into aromas of leather and baking spices. The mouth is packed with flavors of raspberry, blackberry and lavender. Well-balanced tannins and a hint of dark chocolate finish out the long, savory finish.

The abundance of flavors in this wine makes it ideal for pairing with big flavors. We recommend trying it with Mediterranean steak kebabs.
