Sierra Madre Vineyard, Santa Barbara County

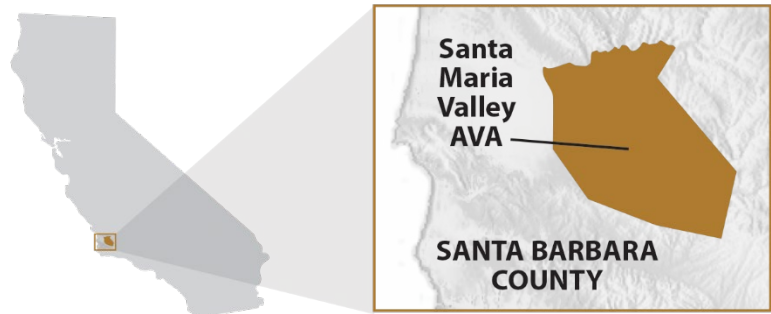

Located in Northern Santa Barbara County, near the western edge of the Santa Maria Valley, one of the state's most coveted appellations. Sierra Madre Vineyard is the coldest vineyard in the state of California, and cold climate viticulture equates to some of the best chardonnay and pinot noir because it is a long growing season, allowing time for complexity to develop.

This is one of our most highly coveted wines that, among other things, has created an amazing reduction for Beef Burgundy. Impress your dinner guest with this show-stopping and award-winning wine.
